



Speakerphone video conference call presets

What is this ?

A set of saved Speakerphone plug-in settings to help you (re)create the typical harsh sounding dialogue from video conferencing (Zoom, Meet, Face time, Skype, whatever) we all experienced to some degree during the COVID-19 pandemic.

You need to insert two Speakerphone plug-ins. Use the PRE presets in the first Speakerphone and the POST presets in the second one. Mix and match and tweak the room mix and the connection quality controls to get unlimited different sounds. Have fun !

Speakerphone plug-in presets

- Copy the two folders from within the **Speakerphone** folder to:

macOS: /Library/Application Support/Audio Ease/Speakerphone/Main Presets

Windows: C:\ProgramData\Audio Ease\Speakerphone\Main Presets

AAX Pro Tools

- Copy the two folders from within the **Pro Tools** folder to:

macOS: /Users/yourusername/Pro Tools/Plug-In Settings/Speakerphone

Windows: C:\Users\yourusername\Documents\Pro Tools\Plug-In Settings\Speakerphone

- Optionally you can copy the content of the **Pro Tools track presets** folder to:

macOS: /Users/yourusername/Pro Tools/Track Presets

Windows: C:\Users\yourusername\Documents\Pro Tools\Track Presets

Audio Unit

- Copy the two folders from within the **Audio Unit and VST** folder to:

/Library/Audio/Presets/Audio Ease/Speakerphone

VST

- Copy the two folders from within the **Audio Unit and VST** folder to:

macOS: /Library/Audio/Presets/Audio Ease/Speakerphone

Windows: C:\Users\yourusername\Documents\VST3 Presets\Audio Ease\Speakerphone

Ableton Live Audio Effect Racks

- Additional to the AU/VST presets (see above) you can copy the content of the **Ableton Live Audio Effect Rack** folder to:

macOS: /Users/yourusername/Music/Ableton/User Library/Presets/Audio Effects/Audio Effect Rack

Windows: C:\Users\yourusername\Documents\Ableton\User Library\Presets\Audio Effects\Audio Effect Rack

Cubase, Nuendo FX Chain

- Additional to the VST presets (see above) you can copy the content of the **Nuendo Cubase FX chain** folder to:

macOS: /Users/yourusername/Library/Audio/Steinberg/FX Chain Presets

Windows: C:\Users\yourusername\Documents\Steinberg\FX Chain Presets

Logic Channel Strip settings
